It has been reported to me that after having put new targets on the Archery practice range at a cost of five hundred dollars a target and purchasing a target for members to use for broad heads someone shot broad heads into the new 25-yard target and cut the face of the target.

All members go through the club orientation and have a copy of range rules, but still things like this happen. I don't know what the answer is to stop this from happening but it has to stop. Any member that sees someone shooting a broad head into the archery target outdoor or indoor need to contact me so I can take the appropriate action to put a stop to this vandalism to club property.

The last issue I have is with range safety and club range rules. Now that the cameras are up and working, I have been monitoring the ranges. I can't understand how careless and irresponsible some club members are. I have watched members handle guns that were loaded while others shooter were down range.

Another very important issue is that members with conceal carry permits are carrying when on the range. The range rules is that all guns must be unloaded and on the bench or in your gun box when the line is safe.

All guns have to have an empty chamber indicator in them when the line is safe and you go down range to set up targets. I have only seen a few people follow this rule.

I could go on with other violations to the range rules, that I have witnessed but I'm not. What I'm going to start doing is when I see someone violating the rules, they will have their range privileges suspended and they will have to attend another range orientation to have them restored.
