President's Message

Mike Brown has informed me that last month's electric bill for the club was over \$1700.00. I believe the reason for this is that we are having members that when using the indoor range turn the building heat pumps to emergency heat at the thermostats.

All members have been told not to change anything on the thermostats when they go thru their orientation. The only action that is allowed when using the indoor range is to push the override switch on the wall by the Southside exit doors.

This has been a very cold winter, the temperatures have been well below the design temperatures that the heat pumps were set up for. When the thermostats are switched to emergency heat, the heat pumps shut down and the system only runs on electric heat, which in this cold weather the heat runs all the time.

We have the members who have tampered with the thermostats on cameras, so at the next Board meeting I will see what the Trustees want to do about this issue.

The Bylaw changes were presented at the February meeting and posted on the website. We sent an email to all members to review the changes and we plan on voting on this at the March meeting.

If anyone thinks we missed something or should correct how the changes are written please contact me before the meeting.

The last issue I have is that we have trees down all over the property, many of these trees are across the fire roads and trails that we need to keep open to access the property, also the NFA range has trees down across the shooting lanes.
